Frosty Nut Ball Cookies

Ingredients:

- ¾ cup ground pecans
- 1 cup butter, softened
- ½ cup powdered sugar
- 1 teaspoon vanilla extract
- 2¼ cup cake flour
- ¼ teaspoon salt
- extra powdered sugar

Stir together pecans, butter, powdered sugar and vanilla and mix well. Sift flour and salt, stir into nut mixture. Chill. Roll into 1-inch balls. Then roll each ball 3 times in the extra powdered sugar. Place 2 inches apart on cookie sheet. Bake at 350 F until set but not brown.

Variation: Divide the powdered sugar into three (or four) bowls, each with a different colour of edible glitter. Then when you roll the cookies in the sugar, they turn out all shiny and sparkly like a Christmas ornament, but they're edible.
