### Caramel Popcorn

Caramel popcorn is the perfect treat for the holiday season. Make a double batch for your family's movie night and then wrap the extra up in decorative cellophane bags and raffia as a delicious gift!

#### Ingredients:

12 cups popped popcorn  
2 cups roasted peanuts  
3/4 cup butter  
1/2 cup corn syrup  
1 generous cup brown sugar, packed  
1/2 teaspoon baking soda  
2 teaspoons vanilla

#### Directions:

Place the popped popcorn in a very large bowl. Melt the butter in a medium saucepan. Stir in the corn syrup and brown sugar. Bring the mixture to a boil and continue to cooking for another 3 or 4 minutes. Remove from heat and stir in the baking soda and vanilla. Pour half the syrup over the popcorn and stir gently. Then stir in the nuts and the remaining syrup. Spread the caramel corn onto waxed paper, cool, and break into pieces.
