The Fort Nelson First Nation went back to its roots this past summer, hosting part of its 2010 Treaty 8 Centennial Commemoration in the traditional village of Old Fort Nelson or Tthekehñ Kue. The Old Fort is located on the east side of the Nelson River, about 25 kilometres from the town of Fort Nelson. It was the location for the First Nation's signing of Treaty 8 with the Crown a century ago and was once a hub of social, political and economic activity.

Northwestel is proud to have been a Gold Level Sponsor for the gathering, which was held from August 13th through 15th at both Old Fort and at a site beside Chalo School, on the Fort Nelson First Nation Reservation.

A mass was held in the church at Old Fort and a cross ceremony took place in the Old Fort cemetery. Other activities included a treaty workshop, historical displays, demonstrations of traditional arts and crafts, hand games, sports, drumming performances, jigging, storytelling, comedy, and much more. The gathering attracted approximately 2000 people from many northern communities.
