104**

OBLIGATION OF THE CUSTOMER

- A. The calling party (or customer) shall establish his identity in the course of any communication as often as may be necessary. (C)
- B. The calling party (or customer) shall be solely responsible for establishing the identity of the person or persons with whom connection is made at the called station. (C)
- C. The customer's use of the radio transmitter at his premises or on the mobile unit shall at all times be subject to the control of the operator at the Company's switchboard. (C)
- D. When equipment at the customer's premises or on the mobile unit is furnished by the Company, the customer is required to provide, install and maintain the storage battery, charging equipment and noise suppressors required for the proper operation of the service. (C)
- E. The customer is responsible for operating equipment in accordance with the terms of his station license, required to be secured by him, the Radio Act and the applicable rules and regulations of the Department of Communications. (C)
