107 USE OF SERVICE BY CUSTOMERS

- (a) Use of the Company's facilities or services for the purpose of resale or sharing, or interconnection of equipment or circuitry to the Company's facilities, shall conform to the appropriate Industry Canada technical standards and the Company's tariffs. The Company's telecommunications services may be shared or resold in accordance with the conditions set out in CRTC 3001, Item 106 "Resale and Sharing". (C)

- (b) The customer shall furnish at his expense any electric power outlets required on his premises. The customer shall also provide the personnel, power, stationery and other supplies required for operation of the station equipment on his premises.
- (c) The magnitude and the character of the voltages and the currents impressed on the Company's channel by the customer provided equipment and wiring and the operation and maintenance of such equipment and wiring shall be such as not to interfere with any of the services offered by the Company or interfere with others. (C)
- (d) Customer equipment attached to the Company's facilities must be in accordance with Northwestel's Connection of Customer-Provided Equipment tariff CRTC 3001, Items 1301, 1302 and 1303.
- (e) The channels and equipment furnished by the Company, or by the Company and its other participating carriers, shall not be connected either directly or indirectly with channel facilities provided other than by such companies, except as provided in this tariff.
