201 **MANUAL MOBILE SERVICE**

1. Definitions

In this item, "Fixed Station" means a fixed residential or business station without access to Ruraltel or conventional telephone facilities.

"Revertive calling" means calling between two mobiles served on the same channel from the same base station.

"Voice call" means any call to a mobile station, that uses a voice call identifier.

2. Description

Manual Mobile service is furnished between a wire telephone and a radio-telephone station through one or more base stations (land radio telephone), or between two radio-telephone stations through more than one base station and through one base station at selected sites.

- 3.** a) A base station is associated with each mobile service area listed in Item 201.6.
- b) Base stations in other parts of Canada and in the United States are listed in the Mobile Telephone Service Rate and Route Pamphlet of the Long Line Department of the American Telephone and Telegraph Company.

4. Conditions

Radio equipment similar to that used in radio-telephone stations located on an island or other place that cannot be served by regular distribution facilities of the Company and is within range of a base station is considered to be a radio-telephone station in the application of rates, charges and regulations.

- a) A network access rate applies to a radio-telephone station as follows:
- i) \$42.00 per month, except for a Fixed Station (A)
 - ii) for a Fixed Station:

Business.....	\$37.20 per month	(A)
Residential.....	\$27.60 per month	(A)
- b) An airtime charge applies to the originating or billing number for local and long distance calls as follows:
- i) from a temporary roamer, landline or radio-telephone station other than a Fixed Station:

\$0.35 per minute or fraction thereof
 - ii) from a Fixed Station:

Originating local calls only..... \$0.06/minute or fraction thereof
- c) A voice call set-up charge applies to the originating or billing number for calls terminating at a radio-telephone station or temporary roamer using a voice call identifier at \$1.00 per call. This charge is waived for Fixed Stations.
- d) A Revertive calling charge applies to an originating radio-telephone station or temporary roamer at \$1.00 per call. This charge is waived for Fixed Stations.
- e) Long distance charges apply.
- f) A non-recurring service charge, which includes the assignment of a billing identifier, applies as per CRTC 3001, Item 302.
