# Bell Listen Only Mailbox User Guide



### 1. Listen Only Mailbox

A Listen Only mailbox allows you record an announcement message for your callers to hear.

It's a great way to easily communicate information that does not require a reply, such as your company's hours of operation.

When calling a Listen Only mailbox, all messages that have been left by a contributor will play automatically. Callers are not able to leave a message in a Listen Only mailbox.

### 2. Setting up your Listen Only Mailbox

#### From your telephone number:

- 1. Dial 1-877-235-5777
- 2. You will hear a standard system recording "Welcome to Bell Toll Free message pick up. Please enter your mailbox number".
- 3. Enter your Listen Only mailbox 10-digit mailbox number.
- 4. The New User Tutorial will then ask you to:
  - Enter your temporary password.
  - Record your name.
  - Change your temporary password to a new password.

#### **Helpful Tips:**

Your password must be between 6 and 15 digits long.

Your password cannot be:

- The mailbox number or any portion of the mailbox number
- The reverse of the mailbox number.
- The same as the previous password.
- A single repeating digit.
- A series of consecutive ascending or descending numbers (such as, 987654).
- An incremental series of ascending or descending odd or even numbers (such as, 2468).

When recording your name, it is a good idea to refer to this mailbox being listen only. For example: "ABC Company listen only mailbox".

### 3. Create Listen Only mailbox Contributor List

Only mailboxes on this list will be authorized to send a message to Listen Only mailbox.

#### To create a Contributor list:

- 1. From the Main Menu, press 4 Personal Options.
- Press 2 Administrative Options.
  Press 2 Establish or change Contributor list and follow the prompts.

## 4. Sending a message to Listen Only mailbox

These will be the messages that your customers will hear when they call your Listen Only mailbox (or you forward your phone to the mailbox).

- 4. Access your Contributor mailbox by dialing \*99 and entering your password.
- 5. At the Main menu, press 2 to send a message.
- 6. At the prompt: enter the 10-digit number of the ICMB and press #.
- 7. At the tone, record your message and press #.
- 8. To send your message, press #

Helpful Tip: Test your message by calling your Listen Only mailbox directly to ensure your message is what you would like your customers to hear when they call.
