## 748 COMMUNITY CONNECT SERVICE

**A. Description**

This service is provided pursuant to an agreement between a specific customer and Northwestel (the “Company”). This service provides building to building loop connections for a customer in specific communities in the Northwest Territories using either:

- a) Copper Wire Service, in the form of a two-wire unconditioned copper loop. The service uses a single pair of copper wires to provide connection between a Customer location and the Company’s central office, where the copper wire pair is connected to a second pair of copper wires in order to provide a link to another Customer location.
- b) Fibre Strand Service, which connects two sites together through the Company’s central office. The service uses a single fibre strand to provide connection between a Customer location and the Company’s central office, where it is connected to a second fibre strand in order to provide a link to another Customer location.
- c) Active Link Service, which is used in locations where fibre is unavailable, and the distance from a customer’s site to the Company’s central office requires electronics to be installed. The Active Link service is used to boost signal strength and does not provide any networking or routing capability. In addition to the required electronics, the service uses a single pair of copper wires to provide connection between a Customer location and the Company’s central office, where they are connected to a second pair of copper wires in order to provide a link to another Customer location.
