TARIFF UPDATE
Northwestel Inc. Tariff Notice 923
Access Services Tariff – Wholesale Connect

NOTE: Effective date – 27 April 2017

This Tariff Notice was submitted to file revisions to Northwestel's Access Services Tariff for Interconnection with Interexchange Carriers, CRTC 21480 Item 300 Wholesale Connect Service; to provide 150 Mbps and 200 Mbps circuits and to add 24 additional type B and C locations.

The final approved tariff pages for Wholesale Connect Service is found in Tariff Notice 976/976A. Attached here is the final CRTC 21480, page 30A which was not included in Tariff Notice 976/976A.

As a result of the Commission's decision in Telecom Order CRTC 2018-338, Tariff Notice 923 is now closed.

For Items 300 E.1 to E.4:

- a) Bandwidth availability is subject to available network capacity at the time of the service request.
- b) Each access link comes with one VRF and one VLAN. For each additional VRF/VLAN, NWTel will charge \$180 monthly fee per VRF/VLAN and \$500 one-time fee per VRF.
- c) Each access link comes with one physical Ethernet port at the demarcation point. If an additional Ethernet port is requested then a one-time charge of \$775 will apply.
